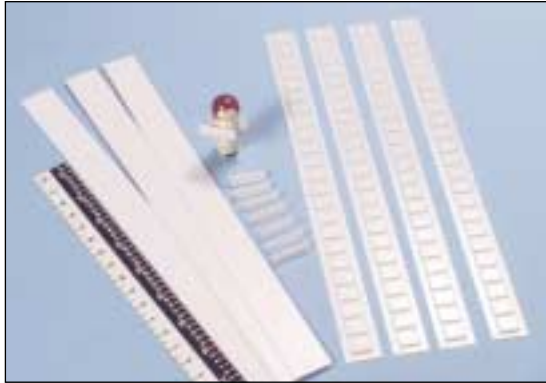


# Instructions for the #11039, #11040 Drawer Divider Kit



#11040 - This kit is designed for full size drawers. Includes: 4 - 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ "H x 23"L (44mm x 584mm) white grooved strips with self-stick tape, 3 white divider strips 2"H x 24"L (51mm x 610mm), and 8 holders with self-stick tape

#11039 - This kit is designed to organize small drawers, totes, boxes, etc. 2 - 2"H x 11"L (51mm x 279mm) white grooved strips with self-stick tape, and 1 white divider strip 2"H x 12"L (51mm x 610mm)



1. Using a tape measure, measure the distance of your drawer, box, etc. from front to back.

**Dividers can be cut and installed to meet your needs. The following instructions are an example to guide you through the layout process using the 11040 kit.**



2. After measuring your drawer, box, etc. get your tape measure and one of the grooved strips. Mark the grooved strip where you want to cut it.



3. Using a pair of scissors, cut the grooved strip at the mark. The strip should be cut to fit the drawer from front to back.

4. Peel away the adhesive strips on the back of the grooved strip you just cut.



5. Press the adhesive side of the grooved strip to the side of the drawer so that the strip travels from front to back.



6. Decide where you would like to divide your drawer next. Measure the distance from the attached grooved strip to the location the next strip will be and mark the spot.



7. Take one of the 8 holders and peel away the adhesive backing.



8. Attach the holder to the back of the drawer where you made a mark for the next grooved strip.



9. Moving to the front of the drawer, measure the same distance over as you did in step 6.

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10. Using another holder, peel away the adhesive backing and press the holder to the mark on the front of the drawer.



11. Measure the distance from the center of the back holder to the center of the front holder.



12. Take one of the divider strips, measure and mark it with the measurement between the holders in step 11.



13. Using HCL's cutting template (1859-01) and retractable knife (1860-01) score the divider strip 3 to 4 times on the mark. (a straight edge and utility knife will work)



14. Position your hands on either side of the score.



15. With hands in position, snap the divider strip.

16. Slide the divider between the holder on the front of the drawer and the holder on the back of the drawer. Attach another grooved strip to the left side of the divider. Make sure it's grooves are aligned with the grooves on the first grooves strip. You are now ready to measure and fit another divider.



17. Once you picked a location for another divider, measure the distance from one groove to another.



18. Mark, score, and break another divider to fit between the grooves. See steps 12-16. Slide the divider strip between the grooves on the grooved strips.



19. Attach another grooved strip on the right side of the front to back divider strip.



20. Attach the last grooved strip to the right side of the drawer.



21. Decide where you would like another divider strip. Refer to steps 12-18. Measure the distance, mark the divider, score the divider, and break it. Slide the divider between the grooved strips and your drawer is divided and ready to organize supplies.
