INSTRUCTIONS FOR

Portable IV Pole, 2-Hook (#1575-01)

PRECAUTIONS

- Never use for IV bags of more than 1200 ml (or 2.5 lbs).
- Pole is most stable at lower height.
- Patient should remain stationary during use.
- Never pull on IV tubing as this may cause pole to tip over.
- Always use attached Velcro to secure IV tubing to pole.
- Never lean on pole or use for support.
- If using rate-controlled gravity set, follow the manufacturer's instructions.

HOW IT WORKS

- 1. Remove the IV pole from the box.
- 2. Determine if pole will be placed on a table top or floor.
- 3. Pull legs outward from the center of the pole and lock into place to secure the base (Figure 1).
- 4. Raise pole sections to desired height and twist each silver pole section firmly clockwise to lock into place (Figure 2).
- 5. Hang IV bag on the hook (Figure 3).
- 6. Secure tubing to pole with Velcro at level of IV site.
- 7. To loosen and collapse pole, first remove IV bag and tubing, then twist each pole section counter-clockwise.
- 8. When no longer needed, place pole in regular recycling.



CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS FOR

Portable IV Pole, 2-Hook (#1575-01)

Stainless Steel IV Stands must be cleaned on a regular basis in order to prevent unnecessary damage to the stainless steel surface. When cleaning the IV Stands, make sure to use the proper cleaning agents and cleaning materials.

CAUTION: DO NOT USE the following materials on the stainless steel surfaces of the IV Stands:

Abrasive Pads

Scrapers

Steel Wool

Wire Brushes

CAUTION: DO NOT USE the following agents on the stainless steel surfaces of IV Stands:

Hard water

Bleach or any products containing Chlorine

Hydrochloric Acid

Denatured Alcohol

NOTE: Always follow the manufacturer's directions for any chemicals used on the stainless steel surfaces of the IV Stands.

Use the following cleaning materials and agents:

Soft clean lint-free cloth

Distilled water

Distilled water with mild detergent

Cleaners approved for use on stainless steel

How to clean a Stainless Steel IV Stand

- 1. Using a damp, lint-free cloth and approved cleaner, wipe down all stainless steel surfaces of the IV Stand.
- 2. Use a lint-free dry cloth to dry the IV Stand, or let air dry. If air drying, ensure IV Stand is completely dry before storing. Store in a cool, dry place.
